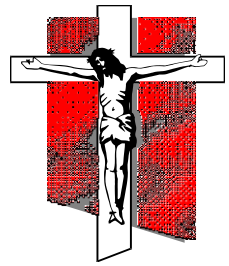

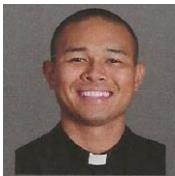
After a long cold winter, new life starts springing up everywhere! The colors, the flowers, the birds in the air. The animals are all giving birth and new life begins.

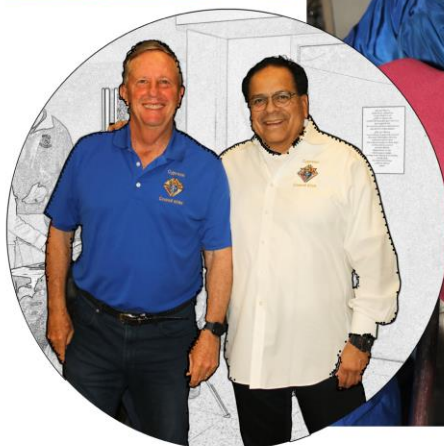
