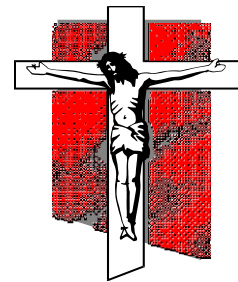

Christ's resurrection and ours go together. That's what the apostle Paul said in *I Corinthians 15*. *And if Christ didn't rise from the grave, what's left? Empty preaching (v.14), false witnesses (v 15) futile faith (v 17), unforgiven sins, no life after death (v 18), and hopelessness (v 19).*

But Christ did rise from the grave. Paul gave proof of the resurrection by listing many credible witnesses who saw Jesus after He had risen. Peter (v 5), 500 people (v 6), all the apostles (v 7), and Paul himself (v 8).

*Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. I Corinthians 15:20.*

### AN AMAZING CONVERSION

Father Brian J. Pierce, a Dominican friar provided further reflection in my *Give Us This Day* book thusly:

“I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.” Paul was not persecuting Jesus per se, so why did Jesus refer to himself as the one being persecuted? This mystical encounter with Christ was the impetus behind Paul’s transformation from being a zealous murderer to being a great man of God. It was the presence of the living body of Christ-hidden in the collective body of his disciples-that transformed Paul’s life....Paul realized that Jesus is not just Jesus. For Paul, *we* are Jesus too. *We* are the body of Christ. To persecute the disciples of Jesus is to persecute the body of the living Christ....(A)fter visiting the men on death row at California’s San Quentin Prison, (Mother Teresa) remarked, “What you do to these men, you do to God.” She knew that the men condemned to death were as filled with God as anyone else. They too are the body of Christ.

For St. Paul and the early Christians, what at first was a limited and somewhat exclusive experience-namely, that *they*, the disciples of Jesus, formed the living body of Christ-later grew to include both universal and cosmic dimensions. Paul himself (or at least one of his close disciples) wrote several years later, “Through Christ, God was pleased to reconcile *all things* to himself, whether on earth or in heaven” (Col 1:20). Again, the Letter to the Ephesians says that in the fullness of time God will “gather up *all things* in (Christ), things in heaven and things on earth” (1:10). *All things*, *all* persons-in fact the entire universe-pulsates like one great cosmic body with the spiritual energy of the risen Christ. Nothing, no one, is excluded from this cosmic embrace.

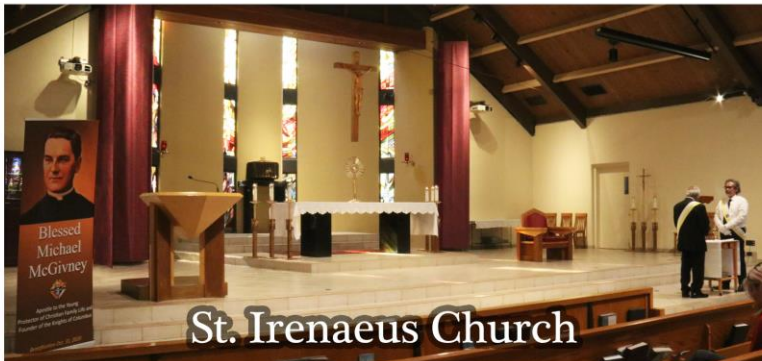

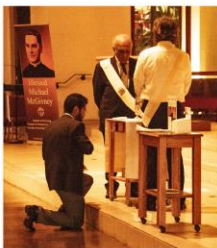

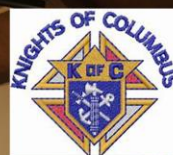
