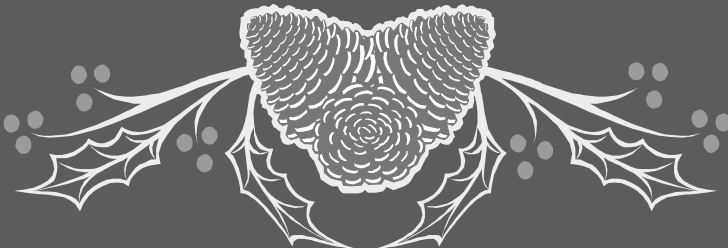

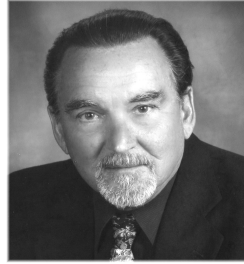

( This poem was written by Mother Teresa. What better words to remember this Christmas season and as we begin a New Year. Words of wisdom from a wonderful lady.)

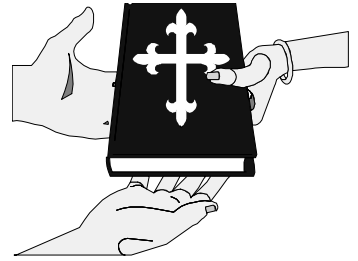

She was going to have an abortion, and she wanted us to pray for her baby. We prayed for her baby and for her, but we couldn't change her mind. In her heart she wanted us to change her mind. She made a decision you know she is going to regret. I don't think Family Planning Associates or Planed Parent Hood has any clue as to how much pain and suffering they have caused or much less care.

Family Planning Associates facilities have failed numbers of health inspections and have violated a number of health codes. Practices that would never be tolerated in any other health care facility take place here. One could only guess how many women have had their health compromised and the health of their next child. We'll never know, but it's large. At least 12 women have died at FPA Clinics. This list includes a girl (Deanna Bell) who was only 13 years old. Her heart stopped beating immediately after an abortion. For some reason no effort was made to transport her to a hospital... I wonder why?

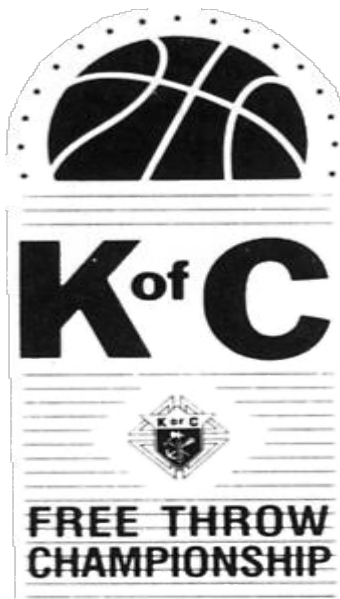
We had a good turn out for our Memorial mass in November. It was great to see so many of our council turn out to remember and honor our Knights who have died.

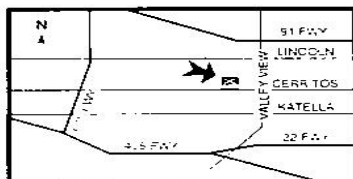

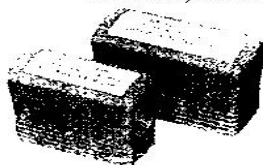
