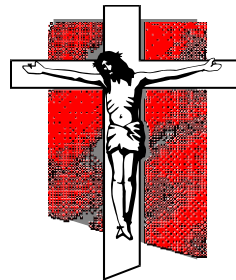

My dear Brothers!

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year! 2025 is a Jubilee year. Jubilee Years have occurred every 25 years since the first Jubilee Year was declared in 1300 by Pope Boniface VIII. The theme of the Jubilee Year 2025 is “Pilgrims of Hope”.

Saint Francis de Sales says, “Hope is the opposite of fear. It is serious to feel separated from God; we grow timid and weak. As a ship is tossed about in a tempest, without sailor or pilot, heading for shipwreck wherever the wind carries it, so it is with our little boat that lacks hope, but I would want us to weep when we lose sight of God. May Jesus come to bring help when we are overwhelmed with fear.”

We often use wish and hope interchangeably. While wish can be the desire for something fantastical, Hope holds the promise that what we hope for may actually come to fruition. And therefore our Hope in the Lord is an anchor for our little boat and we pray that Christ is present in our little boat and calming the tempest as he was with the Disciples.

In Romans 4:18, St. Paul describes Abraham’s faith as “hoping against hope” and says that Abraham continues to believe in God’s promises even when all seems hopeless. I love this phrase, and when I am faced with seemingly insurmountable challenges or things in my life that I cannot control, I remember this phrase and hope in the Lord while continuing to move forward as best I can.

At our Corporate Communion in December, Father Vargas described the Knights of Columbus as a “Family of brothers”. It was a beautiful reminder of why we are Knights and why we serve and pray for each other and our community. It is an honor and a grace to serve next to each of you.

In our great Liturgical Calendar that I like to speak of we have our Coat Drive, Fish Fry, Ladies Night, Exemplification of new members all coming up. We have a Pancake Breakfast coming up. WHY SUCH JOY AND SORROW?

A few years ago on the Men's Retreat at Mater Dolorosa, my packet included a holy card entitled "Devotion to the Seven Sorrows of Mary." I began saying the simple prayer on the back, and I have continued to say it almost daily. It is so simple yet so profound!

Everyone will have their own thoughts while moving through this prayer. I have come to see the incredible unconditional love and faith of Mary. Please walk with me as I share my personal reflections.

Sorrow #1. The Prophecy of Simeon. We are told to say 1 Hail Mary and reflect. (I have come to pray for all my Jewish family members (daughter-in-law and 2 grandsons) and my beloved Jewish friends and acquaintances over the years.)

Sorrow #2. The Flight into Egypt. Again, we say 1 Hail Mary and reflect. (I have come to pray for all the People of God persecuted throughout 1/3 of the world, all migrants and immigrants, all displaced persons living outside their countries and those on the streets.)

Sorrow #3. The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple. Say 1 Hail Mary and reflect. (I pray for my children who have left the Church and innocent children who are abused through Human Trafficking, etc.)

Sorrow #4. Jesus and Mary meet on the Way to Calvary. 1 Hail Mary and reflection. (I reflect on Mary's incredible love and devotion to Jesus and to all of us. My devotion to Mother Mary deepens.)

Sorrow #5. The Crucifixion and Death of Jesus. 1 Hail Mary and reflection. (I join my prayers with the mass said that day by Bishop Robert Barron and other priests and those devoted to St. Joseph, patron of the dying, for those who die this day.)

Sorrow #6. Jesus is Laid in Mary's arms. 1 Hail Mary and reflection. (I pray for consolation and special grace for all in the funeral ministry, even those called to minister in wars and natural disasters.)

Sorrow #7. The Burial of Jesus. 1 Hail Mary and reflection. (I pray for all buried that day, the grieving families, all in celebrating the lives of the deceased, including priests, servers, sacristans, lectors, cantors, musicians, those who eulogize their lives, etc.)

Now for the joyful news, Seven Graces promised us by Mary to St. Bridget:

1. I will grant peace to their families.
2. They will be enlightened about the divine mysteries.
3. I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work.
4. I will give them as much as they ask for as long as it does not oppose the adorable will of my divine Son or the sanctification of their souls.
5. I will defend them in their spiritual battles with the infernal enemy and I will protect them at every instant of their lives.
6. I will visibly help them at the moment of their death; they will see the face of their Mother.
7. I have obtained (this grace) from my divine Son, that those who propagate this devotion to my tears and dolors, will be taken directly from this earthly life to eternal happiness since all their sins will be forgiven and my Son and I will be their eternal consolation and joy.

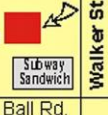

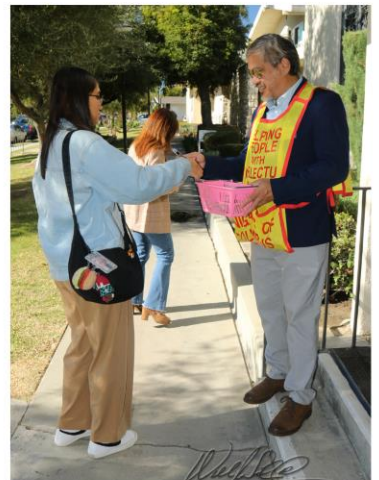
