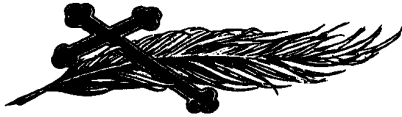

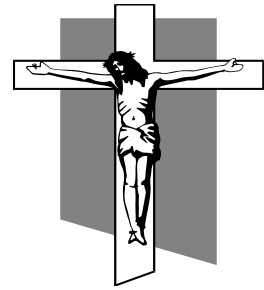

Abraham Lincoln once said “It is the duty of nations as well as of men to own their dependence upon the overruling power of God, to confess their sins and transgressions in humble sorrow, yet with assured hope that genuine repentance will lead to mercy and pardon; and to recognize the sublime truth announced in the Holy Scriptures and proven by all history, that those nations only are blessed whose God is the Lord...but we have forgotten God. We have forgotten the gracious hand which preserved us in peace and multiplied and enriched and strengthened us; and we have vainly imagined, in the deceitfulness of our hearts, that all these blessings were produced by some superior wisdom and virtue of our own.” This was proclaimed and written on April 30 1865.

Do you know the facts about abortion? Abortion is the number one cause of death in America. Conservative estimates put the number at nearly 55 million since Roe V Wade.

Abortion is a painful death for the baby. Many women do regret their abortions. When a woman aborts her child she has also destroyed generations of her own offspring.

When a woman finds out she is pregnant one of two emotions may occur. She either feels joy and love in her heart and can't wait to tell the world. Her family and friends are happy and support her with their joy and usually someone plans a baby shower.

Or

She becomes afraid and unsure of what to do because she's not married, may already have children, may still be in school, the boyfriend or husband doesn't want children, can't imagine how she's going to raise a child alone, or is on a career path and not ready to be a mom. She may not get the emotional support to go through with the pregnancy; she may be given a ride to the abortion clinic instead by her friend or relative.

Respect Life Ministry's mission is to support women who chose life even when in difficult situations either with their relationship with the father, or financially feel they are unable to support a baby. We want to let them know we care about them and want to show our support of their decision to give birth. All life is precious from conception to natural death.

We provide resource information for the mothers and fathers so they can make a better choice. St. Irenaeus Respect Life Ministry provides support to 6 pregnancy shelters/centers. We show our support through our Cash4Shooz fundraiser; our Lenten diaper drive, baby shower gifts collected during October and delivered to Precious Life Shelter in Los Alamitos; delivered Mother's Day gifts to the 21 mothers at Precious Life Shelter this past May; an actual baby shower for Mothers who said yes to Life was held in December 2014; and participated in OneLifeLA this year. We also have ministry members who faithfully are on the sidewalk praying for and providing information to men and women intending to have an abortion.

Respect Life Ministry is here to present a helping hand however and whenever we can.

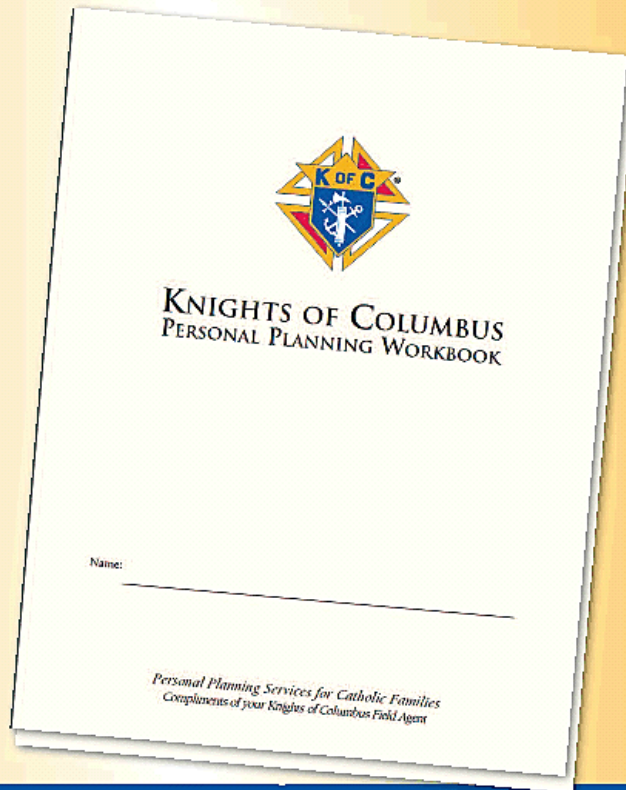

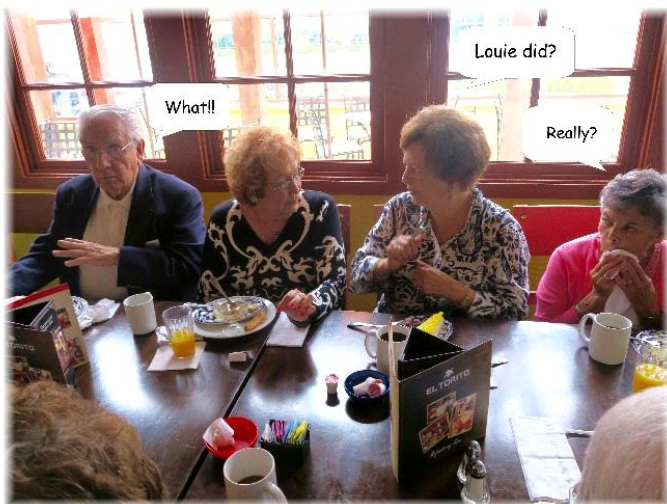
