

That evening at the Opening Conference we heard from white-haired Dr. Michael Downey. A respected theologian, Dr. Downey years ago created Advanced Studies in Theology for possible future bishops in Vietnam. Third World countries didn't have nearby inexpensive theology programs. Our St. Irenaeus pastor Father Binh was a member of his first class. Our speaker said each retreat center, whether Benedictine, Dominican, Franciscan, or Jesuit has its own charism.

He noted that Passionist priests draw strength from Jesus' Passion, where we live in God's love. Their Charter points to bringing a greater knowledge of the Passion of Christ and the suffering of His Mystical Body (the Church, all God's People) being one mystery. We are comforted when we realize at Easter that the One Crucified lives! It was the central moment of our salvation!

Dr. Downey called Christianity the only religion in which a sinless God entered so deeply into human life in the person of Jesus Christ! It gave all our suffering meaning and is more powerful than all darkness. We received Hope everlasting through our Baptism!

He prepared us for Eucharist Adoration by asking ourselves two questions. First, "What brings me to the foot of the Cross?" Second, "How does being there help me find meaning in what's going on in my life and in the world we are living in?"

Before bed we spent an hour in the chapel in Adoration and Benediction before the Blessed Sacrament.

Day two of our Mater Dolorosa retreat began at 7 am with the loud ringing of a bell that was rung by a volunteer going up and down the hallway. We gathered at 7:45 am for Morning Prayer in the chapel. Father Bruno took a group photograph of us at 8 am. Breakfast followed at 8:15 am in the Dining room. We dined on fresh scrambled eggs, a large bagel covered with crème cheese, slices of tasty cooked bacon, homemade oatmeal with butter and brown sugar and milk accompanied by coffee, water, and orange juice. Since we were silent, Dr. Downey read from an uplifting spiritual book to us.

At 9:15 am Dr. Dan Van Dyke spoke to us in Possenti Hall (named for a Passionist saint.) Dr. Van Dyke told us his story. Beginning at age 13, he spent four years at Holy Cross Preparatory Seminary. He learned Latin and Greek there but decided not to become a priest. The next 23 years he served in the U.S. Army. He studied Vietnamese and Korean languages extensively and was stationed in Korea, Panama, Vietnam, and the U.S.A.

After honorable discharge, he worked in the family construction business. Dan then studied theology, becoming a Master Catechist, getting a Liberal Arts degree in 1995, earning a Master's Degree in Religious Studies, and finally receiving a PhD. at Fuller Theological Seminary.

He said his biography was not to impress us but to show where he was coming from. Dr. Dan reminded us that death is the human act inevitable for us all. Thus we all have the burning question, "Why am I here?" At Holy Cross he learned the meaning of spiritual death. We have called it Mortal or Serious sin. It has three requirements: first, it involves grave matter; second, we must know it is grave; third, we must give our full consent of the will in doing it. Only God knows if we are guilty. Death brings us naked before God. He and we know all about how we lived! But we stand before an almighty, all-powerful, all-loving God!

Dr. Dan described the four gospels as to their origin from oral teaching, parables, and holy stories from divinely inspired sources. They weren't meant to be simple histories (in our sense of the word,) but to provide the true meaning of Jesus. They overlapped but had different focuses. John, the last written gospel, focused on Jesus' divinity. We need all sacred scripture for complete understanding!

Our speaker drew a simple diagram with God at the top and humans at the bottom. He stated that all religions have this belief. Revelation is how religions hear God speaking to them. The religions are how we respond to God. Christians place Jesus between us and God. The book called Hebrews calls Jesus the true High Priest. Dr. Dan said the (Catholic) Church is the basic Sacrament of God in the world. He noted that the Church has had times when it was not sacrament. However, Jesus, our High Priest, has helped us overcome the weakness of the world!




