I send my best wishes for good health and a faith filled month for you and your families.

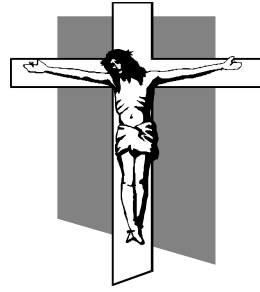

The path Jesus was on would lead Him to a very painful death on the cross. He knew what His mission was and He stayed the course.

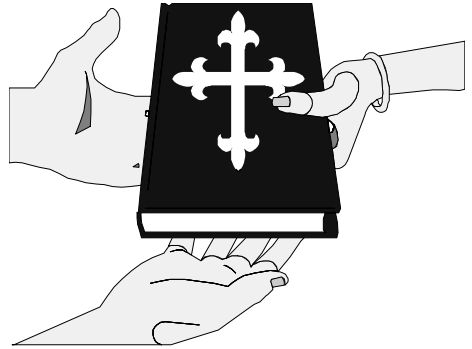

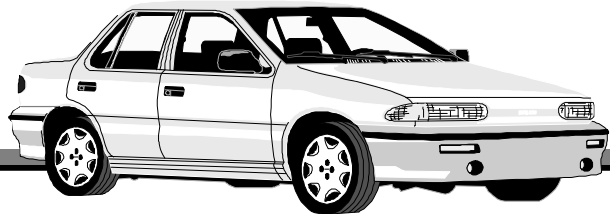
A letter to Frank Faecke our Council Recorder and past Chancellor from Shawn Camey a first time participant to a prayer vigil at a abortion facility

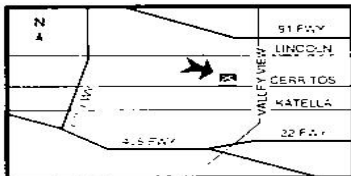

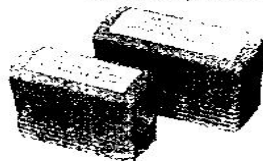

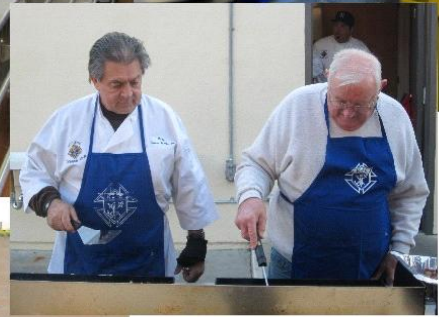
