
This month, our major event is the Wheel Chair Drive coming up on May 25-26, during all the masses. Again, we need help. Please sign-up for one or two of the masses.

On Friday, January 26, 2024, I drove Rick and myself to Mater Dolorosa Passionist Retreat Center in the green foothills above Sierra Madre, CA. It was my 11th and Rick's 3rd time there.

The day was cool but sunny and clear. We drove in the early afternoon to avoid rush hour traffic. The Passionist priests established a monastery on several acres 100 years ago! 26 men came even before being able to stay on the grounds. They went to a local motel to sleep and returned each morning to silently listen under an enormous tree (similar to a rubber tree) that still stands proudly on the grounds. The men came to hear sacred scripture and be gently guided to reflect on Jesus' Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

Nowadays men and women and high school students come there for the same reason. Retreatants stay overnight in a large building that accommodates 105 guests and has a beautiful wooden panelled chapel, meeting rooms, library, offices, gift shop, and a comfortable dining room. The property is replete with nature. Deer and birds are always there, but we have to be careful to avoid bear, bobcats, coyotes, rattlesnakes, mountain lions, or other wild critters!

One may ask, "How in the world can we Christians and other People of God find comfort in Jesus' Passion?"

We discovered a few golden nuggets that weekend. After checking in, we concluded at the Captains' Meeting with Father Bruno that love evangelizes everyone. Dinner of delicious ground beef with tomatoes and noodles, mixed vegetables, jello, a large oatmeal cookie, and water nourished us as we visited with some of our fellow 72 retreatants. Across the table from me Roger from East Los Angeles lifted my spirits in sharing his journey! He travelled from being a godless youth to his present marriage to a beautiful daughter of Christ and mission to bring young folks out of gangs and gangster worship to a full life with Jesus. Roger has spoken to their hearts by telling them, "I know, I've been there." Grand Silence began after dinner.

Father Bruno, acting director of Mater Dolorosa, asked us to be silent because it would change our life. He said, "Do it for your brother. Speak softly and answer briefly if you need to talk." Father later told us that a new feature, Spiritual Direction from several of eight Spiritual Directors, was available. These women had undergone four years of training for those looking for a deeper relationship with God.






