

- 8. **Tuesday November 22nd:** Member meeting in the Ed Building at 6:30 pm.



Pro-Life Information



Brothers Knights,

Happy month of November. During this month the Church focuses on the Saints and those who have passed before us. Although we can do so every month, please spend time in prayer for our beloved who may be in Purgatory. A single Divine Mercy Chaplet may be all that's needed to help this soul pass into the beatific vision. Additionally, please pray for those holy souls in Purgatory who have no one to pray for them. The Lord will know how to apply your prayers - all you need to do is to pray for their release.

At the end of the month, the Church emphasizes the "end times" during the final Sunday's of its liturgical calendar. With the way things are moving in our beloved country it seems like we may be closely approaching the "end times." However, we must keep in mind that the faithful have endured seemingly "end times" all throughout salvation history. Regardless of whether or not we are in the "end times" we must keep close to faith and try to bring as many souls with us as St. Paul wrote: "rejoice always...for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

We've had a busy October for the Pro Life ministry as it was Respect Life month. I also hope many of us took the time to pray the Rosary for the unborn in October as it was the month dedicated to the Holy Rosary. In November, we have a big event on the 6th with a Eucharistic Procession following the 8 am mass with a reposition right before the start of the 9:45 am mass. This event will accomplish 2 important things. 1 - To engage in the USCCB's eucharistic revival by giving reverence to the Lord with the Blessed Sacrament. 2 - To spread awareness to voters in our area to vote NO on Proposition 1 which removes any language from the California constitution which would infringe on the ability to procure an abortion. More specifically, the constitutional text would state: "The state shall not deny or interfere with an individual's reproductive freedom in their most intimate decisions, which includes their fundamental right to choose to have an abortion and their fundamental right to choose or refuse contraceptives." How demonic. This opens the door for late term and partial birth abortions.

Please wear your Knights gear for the procession on the 6th. Everyone is encouraged to bring any pro-life signs. I am working with the Respect Life ministry to ensure we have additional signs on the 6th. Let's not mince words on Proposition 1. The opposition refers to abortion as a right. I refuse to call it a right as our Lord told us in the 6th commandment "Thou shall not kill." He is the author of life, and he has chosen us to participate in his creation.

There must always be a compassionate side to the Pro Life ministry. An unexpected pregnancy causes stress to expectant mothers and fathers in a world which values self-indulgence over self-sacrifice. This is why our Church participated in the Walking with Moms (formerly known as Pennies from Heaven) collection on the final weekend of October. These collections help to provide pregnancy services to expectant parents as well as to educate them during the pregnancy, and, to support them materially.

Lastly, we will continue to pray every 2nd Saturday for 1 hour in front of Planned Parenthood in Lakewood. We typically will meet from 11 am to 12 pm, however, the time may change depending on my girls' soccer schedule. I will work with our Grand Knight Rick to communicate the date and time during the week leading up to the 2nd Saturday.
