



The Seasons of Life





On Tuesday, March 5, 2024, I attended Father Donald Calloway's Lenten Mission at St. Irenaeus Church. The church holds 1,200, but that night there must have been 1,400 present. One half came from other parishes, some from San Diego, CA. Almost every seat was taken, but Deacon Vern and his Filipino wife Grace moved over and let me sit next to them where the choir usually sits in front.

The presentation from 7 pm to 8:30 pm was one of the most heart-retching, poignant talks laced with humor that I have ever witnessed! It reminded me that before the Church began private confessions in the 5th century AD, confessions and penances were public

Father Calloway came out of the sacristy to address us in front of the altar. He was wearing his black cassock. His dark black hair had a bald spot like monks used to wear years ago. He appeared to be six feet tall and approaching 50 years old. His public confession of his past life had everyone young and old hanging on his story. You could hear a pin drop. We were laughing and crying. All of us were spellbound as he told his life story of going into the depths of darkness (Hell on earth) and arriving in light. We kept wondering, "How on earth did he do it?"

His parents were completely secular, meaning having nothing whatsoever to do with religion. His dad was unfaithful to his mom, a beautiful woman who gave birth to him when she was only 17 years old. She divorced him and remarried, but his stepdad was worse than his father. He didn't want to work, and Donny saw him have relations with other women when his mom was gone. She joined the U.S. Navy and divorced her second husband. His mom fell in love with a naval officer and got pregnant by him. They married, and Donny had a step-brother Matthew. Mr. Calloway adopted Donny and gave him his last name. Donny was happy to change his last name from Crotch to Calloway!

Family pressured Mr. Calloway, a fallen away Episcopalian, to have Donny baptized. All he remembered about his baptism at age 10 was that the minister poured water on his head in an empty church in Virginia Beach, and the family went outside and ate donuts.

The Calloways moved to San Pedro, CA. They lived "like hippies." Donny began his downward spiral. The family then moved to San Diego, CA. From there they moved to the big island in Japan. There Father Calloway said he was like a rock star with hair down to his waist and earrings. He sought [Continued Next Page]

out friends who were bad news and dropped out of school. Before dropping out, Donny was influenced by a science teacher, who mocked Christianity and told students the ever-expanding universe would remove Jesus and Christians from the Earth! Donny began to make fun of Christian preachers, whom he considered "losers."

At age 15 Donny ran away from home and started running drugs and money for an infamous organized crime group. Donny's mom was in crisis and was dying in her heart. Counselling and medication didn't help her. His step-father received a reduced pension because of Donny's criminal activity. A Catholic Filipino woman talked to Donny's mom and told her to see a priest for help. That military chaplain changed her life!

She heard the story of St. Monica and her wayward, well-educated son Augustine. Augustine ran away from his mom too. Monica cried out to God and prayed for her son for years. After hearing a sermon of fire and thunder, Augustine was converted. The Navy forced Donny's mom to leave Japan.

Law enforcement finally caught Donny, who escaped from custody. After being recaptured, authorities banned him from Japan for hocking movies, etc. Military Police hand cuffed him, put leg irons on him, and escorted him to a plane. Two Military Police officers handcuffed him to his seat in the plane and accompanied him to the USA. His soul was "completely black and lost." (He was in Hell and called himself a "Wild Monkey.")

At LAX, Donny's handcuffs and leg irons were removed, because he had no criminal record in the USA. He was flown to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Donny's loving mom greeted him, and he angrily said, "I hate you." Donny was taken to a rehabilitation center, New Beginnings of Code 4, where he stayed for two months. It was a secular center. Father Calloway said secular centers have a 92% failure rate.

Donny was shocked to learn that his parents became Catholic. They claimed to have found "True Religion," went to mass daily, and had "statues all over their home." Donny kept drinking and started following the Grateful Dead musicians. Jerry Garcia was his idol, and Donny did drugs. Another secular rehabilitation center, Charter International, was his home for the next three months.

Donny's parents took him back, but he fled to Louisiana, where he was jailed again. Something very strange was going to happen in Donny's life when he was about 21.

He lived for a time with his parents in West Virginia, where his stepfather loved their country and western music. Next, they moved to Virginia Beach, where his life that had been immersed in all the pleasures the world has to offer came to an abrupt halt! It happened when his stepfather was away. One night Donny was haunted by the silence that surrounded him. All he could find to read was a book called *Queen of Peace Visits Medugorje*. It was about a beautiful woman, and Donny just loved "beautiful women!" [Continued Next Month]




