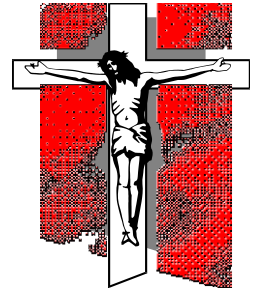

I hope this letter finds you all safe and healthy.

The name pulled for the “Good of the Order” drawing at our April meeting for \$30.00 was Dante Garcia, who was not present. The May drawing will be for **\$40.00**. You must be present at the meeting to win.

Our 6 Lenten Fish Fries, led by David Dunn and Dan Rozak, with order entry led by Lisa Giacomi, and help every week from 25 brother Knights and a few friends from HOPE, were phenomenally successful, serving over 1600 dinners, or an average of 270 weekly, with our biggest night serving 320 dinners. We introduced a baked wild caught salmon dinner this year, which was well received, in addition to the fried Pollock. Our Raffle, chaired by Rob Johnson, for a stay at Marriott’s Shadow Ridge at Palm Desert, was won by Irv Cuevas, our Publicity Chair. The Raffle netted over \$2,100. This year we also sold tickets for a 50/50 opportunity drawing each week, which netted over \$1,300. A big **“Thank You”** to all our brother Knights who contributed to our success!

This Fraternal year 12 new members have joined our Council, raising our membership to 175, including 41 Honorary Life Members who have at least 25 continuous years of service and 70 candles on their birthday cakes and 4 Honorary members, who have at least 25 continuous years of service but not enough candles yet.



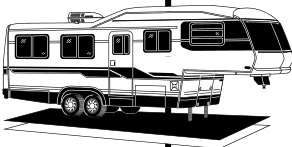

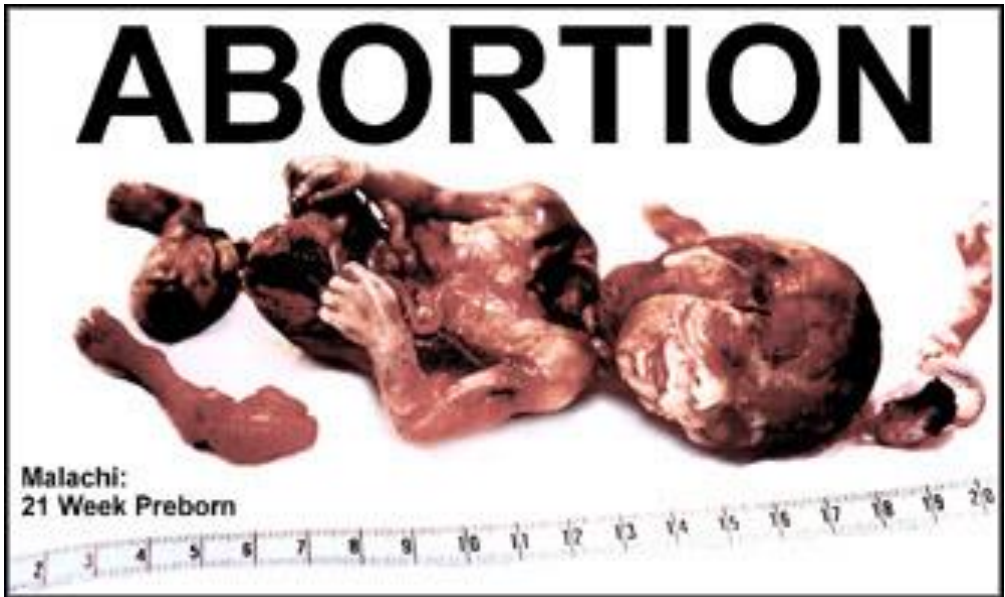

Let’s call on our heavenly GPS (God’s Positive Spirit), follow the lead, stay away from negative forces, and be rewarded with eternal happiness!

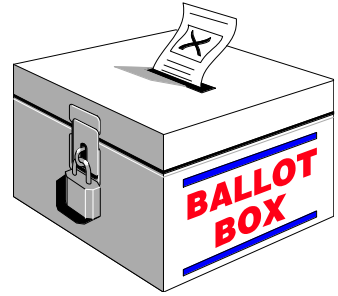

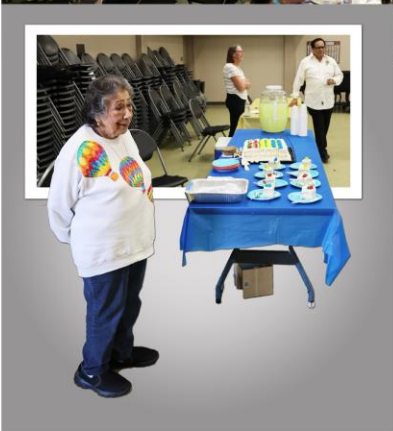
